Day 1: Depart Home – Arrive Fairbanks

Transfer to the airport for your flights to Fairbanks. Upon arrival we will be greeted and transferred to our hotel for the first night.

Day 2: Fairbanks

Our tour starts first thing this morning as we are transferred to our first tour of the trip. We will be in for a treat on the Riverway and slow paced paddle boat up Scenic River.

Afternoon at leisure to enjoy our stay at the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge is the perfect base camp for exploring **Denali National Park**. The name "Denali" means "The Great One" in the native Athabascan language. At 20,320 feet above sea level. Denali is the highest peak in North America and is surrounded by one of the world's most spectacular wildlife sanctuaries.

Day 3:

Morning at leisure to explore and take in the beauty of Denali – you have the option of taking in some Denali Park Tours (not included in package).

This afternoon you are in for a treat as we are going to explore Denali with the Park Tours – Natural History Tour departs between 2-3:30 pm (you have the option to upgrade this tour for extra cost and get further into the park. This tour is hosted by the National Park system and is not by Motor-Coach.

Day 4:

Morning at leisure; this afternoon we will depart by Motor-Coach to Mt. McKinley. *Mt. McKinley* and the Alaska Range are simply stunning. Our lodge is located approximately one hour from the town of Talkeetna, which is nestled at the base of Mt. McKinley and is also home to the Talkeetna, Chulitna & Susitna Rivers.

Afternoon at leisure to enjoy the scenery – optional tours available. Overnight Mt. McKinley Lodge

Day 5:

This morning we will transfer from our lodge by Motor-Coach to the Rail Depot for one of our highlights of the trip. From the train station in Talkeetna we will travel in class to Whittier by Dome Rail. Take in the beauty. Watch for Moose, Sheep and Bear!

Whittier, approximately 65 miles southeast of Anchorage, lies nestled at the base of the Chugach Mountains bordering Passage Canal. Established as a World War II port for cargo and troops of the Alaska Command, Whittier remained activated until 1960. •

Day 6:

Our Cruise first sights: The largest tidewater glacier in North America, *Hubbard Glacier* measures 76 miles long and plunges 1,200 feet into the depths of the bay. Its immense beauty and Phenomenal blue hues are enchanting, even from afar.

Day 7:

Cruising Glacier Bay:

Princess is one of a select few cruise lines permitted to cruise the pristine waters of *Glacier Bay*, the highlight of our 7-day Voyage of the Glaciers cruise. Just west of Juneau, this breathtaking national park and preserve boasts some of the world's most spectacular tidewater glaciers, such as Margerie Glacier, which often drops colossal chunks of ice into the sea.

Day 8:

Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields for the thousands who flocked to Alaska and the Yukon with the hope of striking it rich. Skagway may have boasted the shortest route to the Klondike, but it wasn't the easiest.

Day 9:

Juneau:

Some 30,000 people live in *Juneau*. Its total area makes it one of the biggest towns, in size, in the world. Only Kiruna, Sweden, and Sitka, Alaska, exceed Juneau's 3,248 square miles.

You will be intrigued by its rich Native heritage, which includes the world's oldest collection of totem poles at Totem Heritage Center. The Haida, Tlingit and Tsimshian are all a part of the city's colorful history. • Canada's third-largest city,
