DAY 1 - 14 OCTOBER 2016: MEMPHIS

Welcome to Memphis, birthplace of Blues and Rock 'n' Roll. Enjoy a guided tour of Rock 'N' Soul Museum and explore the birth of rock and soul music exhibitions, created by the Smithsonian Institution.

Learn the story of musical pioneers who, for the love of music, created the sound that shook the entire world. In the evening, join your fellow guests on legendary Beale Street for a Highlight Dinner at Itta Bena, a 1920s speakeasy-style restaurant above BB King's Blues Club.

DAY 2 - 15 OCTOBER 2016: MEMPHIS

This morning enjoy a Memphis Mojo tour - the Home of Blues comes alive on this city tour aboard the nation's only music bus. Professional Beale Street musicians play and sing selections from the city's rich





musical heritage, while entertaining you with comedy, history, and behind-the scenes stories of your favorite Memphis personalities. Along the way, you will see: Sun Studio, Beale Street, Stax Studio, The Lorraine Motel, Cotton Row, Peabody Hotel, Overton Park, Historic Central Gardens, St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, and early homes of Elvis, B. B. King, and Johnny Cash (see not visit/enter).

This afternoon you have the option to visit GRACELAND, as much an object of pilgrimage as a museum dedicated to the late, great Elvis Presley. From the flowers and painted signs outside the gates, to

DAY 3 - 16 OCTOBER 2016: MEMPHIS - NATCHEZ


Today, depart for VICKSBURG NATIONAL MILITARY PARK where the famous Civil War battle is remembered and commemorated. The park features, among many things, 1,325 historic monuments and markers, 20 miles of trenches, 2 antebellum houses, and 144 emplaced cannons.

Continue to Natchez where, later, you will whet your palate before dinner during a mixology class to learn the 'science' of making a signature drink of the South, the mint julep. Then enjoy a delectable dinner at your hotel.

HOTEL: Monmouth Plantation.

DAY 4 - 17 OCTOBER 2016: NATCHEZ - NEW ORLEANS

Stop at Frogmore Plantation today and journey back to a time when cotton was king. With your costumed hosts, tour a reconstructed 19th century plantation and compare it to the modern day operation that produces more than 900 bales of cotton each day. Get a glimpse into the sweet side of the South with a visit to Houmas House Plantation, once the largest producer of sugar in the country.



Later, in New Orleans, visit the New Orleans School of Cooking and enjoy a demonstration of a popular Creole Highlight Dinner.

HOTEL: Monteleone (3 Nights).

DAY 5 - 18 OCTOBER 2016: NEW ORLEANS

Join a local expert in the atmospheric French Quarter and visit Jackson Square, originally called Place d'Armes when it was the center of the Old City. Wind your way through the twisted paths of one of the 'Cities of the Dead', the above-ground final resting place of pirates, politicians and voodoo queens.

Enjoy beignets at Cafe Du Monde, established in 1862 and then visit Sazerac Bar and learn how to make the famed Sazerac. Your evening is free to explore and have dinner on your own.

DAY 6 - 19 OCTOBER 2016: NEW ORLEANS

Enjoy some time at leisure today to savor more that New Orleans has to offer. Many of you may be interested in visiting The National WWII Museum, voted #1 tourist attraction in New Orleans and #4 US museum by TripAdvisor. Founded in 2000 as the D-Museum, The National WWII Museum consists of over 178,000 square feet of engaging content and multi-sensory exhibits.

This evening, join together for a Celebration Dinner at a famous New Orleans restaurant.

DAY 7 - 20 OCTOBER 2016: NEW ORLEANS - HOME

In the morning, get up-close and personal with the rural side of the Crescent City as you embark on a boat tour to meet the resident alligators and other flora and fauna.

Later, bid 'Au Revoir' to the Big Easy.
