11th Depart from Omaha Eppley Airfield

12th Upon arrival we will be met and transferred to our hotel in central Paris. The afternoon and evening are yours to enjoy.

13th Breakfast at the hotel. At 9:30am we'll meet in the lobby for a guided tour of Paris, viewing all the iconic sites, Eiffel Tower, Arc D'Triomphe, Champs Elysees, Place de la Concorde and more. This evening, stroll St. Germain-Des-Pres, enjoy dinner at a quaint bistro or take a boat cruise on the River Seine. *B

14th Today we depart for Isigny-Omaha to meet our newest friendship city members. Our first stop mid-morning is Giverny, the Home and Gardens of Claude Monet. Continuing on we'll make a stop at Rouen; built along the River Seine, Vikings settled this valley and became Normans in the 10th century. Visit the memorial to Joan of Arc, who ended up on the funeral pyre here in 1431. Rouen is where Julia Childs enjoyed her first French meal. Continuing on we will check in to our hotel where dinner will be offered. BD

17th We will depart this morning for an excursion to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Mont-St-Michel. Built between the 11th and 16th centuries, the Abbey is a technical and artistic tour de force, having had to adapt to the problems posed by this natural site. The Benedictine Abbey, founded in 966 was erected on a sanctuary dedicated to the Archangel Michel. B

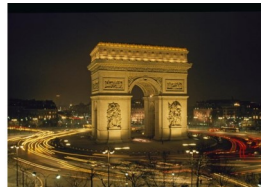

The linkage between Omaha and the Isigny-Omaha communities was permanently established on June 6, 1944 when the Allied liberation of Europe began on D-Day, with Omaha Beach being one of the landing sites. Historically, the relationship between France and America dates back to the beginnings of the United States.

With this year marking the 75th Anniversary of D-Day, and with the recent establishment of Isigny-Omaha Intercom as a governmental entity uniting 59 small communities in the area, leaders in the US and France initiated visits to both areas. These exchanges led to the development of the formal friendship agreement, and may ultimately lead to a full Sister City relationship in the future.
