Peru & Machu Picchu Itinerary

Day 1: Flight to Lima, Peru

Board your flight to Lima, Peru, meet your **Local Trip Expert/Guide** and transfer to your hotel. Enjoy your evening before embarking on this amazing adventure. *Overnight: Lima*

Day 2: Lima

Embark on a **Lima City Tour** featuring the Plaza Mayor, official center of the city and the original site upon which Lima was founded. Also see the Cathedral, the Presidential Palace, the Church of San Francisco & visit the fascinating Archaeological Museum. Enjoy lunch at the famous, **Rosa Nautica Restaurant**. This afternoon explore Lima on your own. This evening enjoy a **Local 'Casa' Hosted Dinner & Cocktail**.

Meals: (B, L, D) Overnight: Lima

Day 3: Lima - Cuzco - Urubamba

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Cuzco, an Andean community and former ancient capital of the Inca Empire. Upon arrival, transfer to the **Sacred Valley** for a two night stay. The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax & acclimate as you are now at an altitude of 8500 feet. We recommend minimal activity and the plentiful local remedy of coca tea.

Meals: (B, D) Overnight: Urubamba

Day 4: Urubamba Valley

Depart for the Urubamba Valley to the local village of **Pisac**, known for its colorful market. Try your hand at bartering for local sweaters, ponchos, wall hangings & jewelry. Also visit the **Awanakancha Breeding Center** where Llamas, Alpacas, Guanacos & Vicunas are bred. Continue to the massive **Ollantaytambo Fortress**. This formidable stone structure climbs massive terraces & was the valley's main defense.

Meals: (B, L) Overnight: Urubamba

Day 5: Urubamba - Machu Picchu

Board the **Vistadome Train for Machu Picchu** and begin your exploration of the legendary "Lost City of the Incas". On your guided **Machu Picchu Excursion** explore the ancient city's ruins as you visualize the lives of the priests, craftsmen & servants who inhabited the site. Machu Picchu is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and was not modern day accessible until the 1940's when the Inca Trail was discovered by an archeological expedition. Enjoy **Lunch** at the **Machu Picchu Sanctuary Lodge**.

Meals: (B, L, D) Overnight: Machu Picchu

Day 6: Machu Picchu - Cuzco

This morning enjoy a bit of leisure time. Maybe return to Machu Picchu for a final visit where you can enjoy a short hike or further explore the incredible ruins at your own pace. Later return to **Cuzco** by rail. Enjoy dinner at your hotel tonight.

Meals: (B, D) Overnight: Cuzco

Day 7: Cuzco

Enjoy a **Cuzco City Tour** including the Cathedral and the Dominican Church & Convent. Continue to the **Sacsayhuaman Ruins**, compiled of massive stones--each weighing 125 tons. Also visit **Qenqo** ("The Labyrinth"), an Incan shrine dedicated to Pachamama ('Mother Earth'). Lunch will be served at your hotel followed by an afternoon at leisure. This evening enjoy dinner at a local restaurant featuring traditional **Andean Folkloric Music & Dancing**.

Meals: (B, L, D) Overnight: Cuzco

Day 8: Cuzco - Lima - Flight Home

Transfer to the airport in Cuzco for a flight to Lima. Tonight fly home with exciting memories of your experiences in Peru & Machu Picchu.

CANCELLATION WAIVER & POST DEPARTURE PLAN
