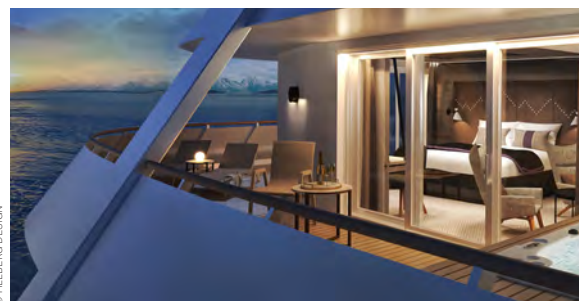

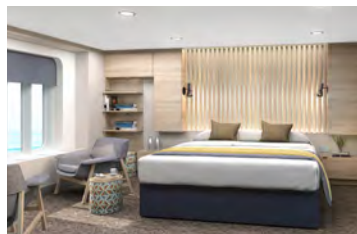

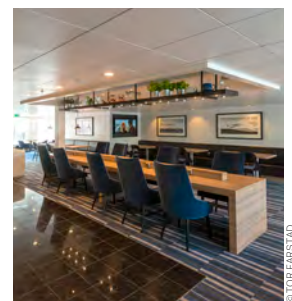

PROTECTING ARCTIC WILDLIFE

Hurtigruten is a participant in the Norwegian Polar Institute's project to register marine mammals in the Arctic. Gathering this data improves insight on habitat use and seasonal migration patterns, and is used in the Environmental Monitoring of Svalbard research initiative.

AIDING IN RESEARCH

We contribute to real-time oil surveillance along the Norwegian coast. We also collaborate with scientific communities internationally, providing important knowledge and information about the Arctic and Antarctica.

BANNING SINGLE-USE PLASTIC

Plastic pollution is the single biggest threat to our oceans. Hurtigruten is the first cruise line in the world to ban all unnecessary single-use plastic. Starting in July 2018, everything—from straws to drinking glasses and plastic bags—has been removed or replaced by environmentally friendly alternatives made of biodegradable paper and other sustainable materials.



Sustainability is at the core of every part of the Hurtigruten operation and experience. CEO Daniel Skjeldam is personally engaged in these projects, such as removing single-use plastic.

PRESERVING OUR WATERS

Hurtigruten is actively advocating a ban on polluting and toxic heavy fuel oil (HFO) in all Arctic waters and along the entire Norwegian coast.

Fighting mass tourism in vulnerable areas is also an important part of the Hurtigruten philosophy. We support stricter regulations in pristine destinations, such as cruise ship size limitations, and restricting the number of guests allowed on shore.



LEADING THROUGH TECHNOLOGY

Innovation is at the heart of our tradition and culture, based on 125 years of exploration in some of the world's most challenging waters. With the introduction of the world's first hybrid electric-powered cruise ships—and the conversion of existing ships to hybrid LNG-battery power—Hurtigruten sets a new standard for the next generation of adventure travel.

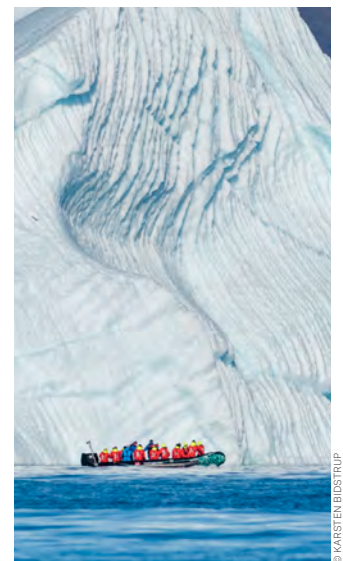


CLEANING UP OUR BEACHES

For years, Hurtigruten has worked to raise awareness of marine pollution as a major problem for the oceans. Engaging and involving our guests in different initiatives, such as beach clean-ups, is an important part of our fight.



The Hurtigruten Foundation was established in order to ensure that our guests of tomorrow can enjoy the same meaningful travel experiences our guests do today. The Hurtigruten Foundation supports a number of projects, such as protecting the polar bear population, fighting plastic and marine pollution, and raising awareness and supporting local initiatives in the areas we explore.



ENVIRONMENTAL PARTNERSHIPS

Hurtigruten believes in leading by example, and we encourage cooperation throughout the travel industry. We were actively involved in establishing the Association of Arctic Expedition Cruise Operators (AECO), which oversees Arctic expedition cruising and is dedicated to responsible, environmentally friendly, and safe tourism in the Arctic.
