Wednesday, February 14

Check in at Omaha's Eppley Airfield mid-day for the first leg of the overnight trans-Atlantic flight to London. Meal service and movie in flight.

Thursday, February 15

We'll travel by motor coach to a conveniently located superior tourist class hotel. For transportation throughout your stay (including free time), each tour member will receive a London Oyster Travel Card good for excellent public transit all over London. This is your first day to experience a theatre performance in the West End and get started on your discovery of what London has to offer.

Friday, February 16

After continental breakfast at the hotel, you are free to continue your London adventure on your own. Check out one of the city's unique restaurants or stop for tea. Find your seat in another beautiful London theatre for today's performance.

Saturday, February 17

After continental breakfast, make plans for which London experience will be yours to enjoy on your own. In the afternoon, we will meet at the National Theatre for a backstage tour followed by an evening performance—one of our highlights each year.

Sunday, February 18

After breakfast, we are off on a Cotswolds' day-trip for a privately arranged tour/luncheon at Chavenage, a 16th century manor house. In 1944, the US Army was embedded here, along with General Eisenhower, where the planning for the WWII D-Day Landing at Omaha Beach took place. Many movies/TV series (Poldark) have been filmed in this Lowesly-Williams family home, virtually unchanged for 400 years. At the end of the trip, we will gather for our farewell tradition at London's landmark fish and chips shop, Rock and Sole Plaice.

Monday, February 19

We're off to the airport! Part of our group will head home today, and others will join us for this year's Optional 4-Night Tour Extension to Hamburg, Germany.
